



Public Health & Social Justice Internships

Left Turn Village has unpaid internships available for people who are studying or have an interest in public health, gender studies, LGBTQ+ interests, social justice, and/or related areas. Interns will have the opportunity to participate in needs assessments, evaluations, development and delivery of trainings, implementing social media campaigns, the creation of health education materials and other projects. All internships are remote and interns will report directly to Dr. Tyree Oredein.

Responsibilities may include working on or assisting with the following activities

- Developing and delivering of workshop and trainings
- Writing program descriptions and objectives
- Developing and assessing program evaluation tools
- Developing and analyzing needs assessments
- Creating and designing effective health education materials.
- Finding articles, stories, activities, resources, and/or other content to supplement programming, and/or to share via social media
- Creating infographics and relevant content for diversity and awareness observances
- Posting content and monitoring interactions on company social media platforms
- Researching and synthesizing information relevant to current and prospective projects
- Identifying opportunities and conducting outreach efforts for public health programs
- Report and/or manuscript writing
- Conducting general research and outreach relating to current and prospective projects.
- Attending meetings with clients as needed (virtual unless otherwise indicated)
- Attending conferences, webinars, etc. (virtual unless otherwise indicated)
- Assisting with other duties and projects as needed.

Qualifications & Requirements

- Minimum of introductory Public Health course, and/or progress toward a degree in Public Health, Gender Studies, Social Justice, Community Organizing or related field (highly preferred)
- Regular and reliable access to a computer and high speed internet and smartphone
- Slack account (communication app)
- Strong verbal, written, communication and analytical skills
- Ability to work independently
- Knowledge of and comfort discussing privilege, power, sexual violence, substance use, mental health, disability, sexuality, bias, and other sensitive subject matters.

- Prior experience with workshop facilitation or presenting.

She is an Adjunct Professor at Montclair State University in the Department of Public Health, and served as a Special State Officer on the Healthy New Jersey 2030 Advisory Council under the auspices of the NJ Department of Health. She created Left Turn Village, a public health and social justice consulting company, in 2020.
